The power of the water erodes the rock beneath the falls—historically by as much as one metre per year! Due to modern water diversion and erosion control, it’s now slowed to about 30 cm (one foot) every 10 years.

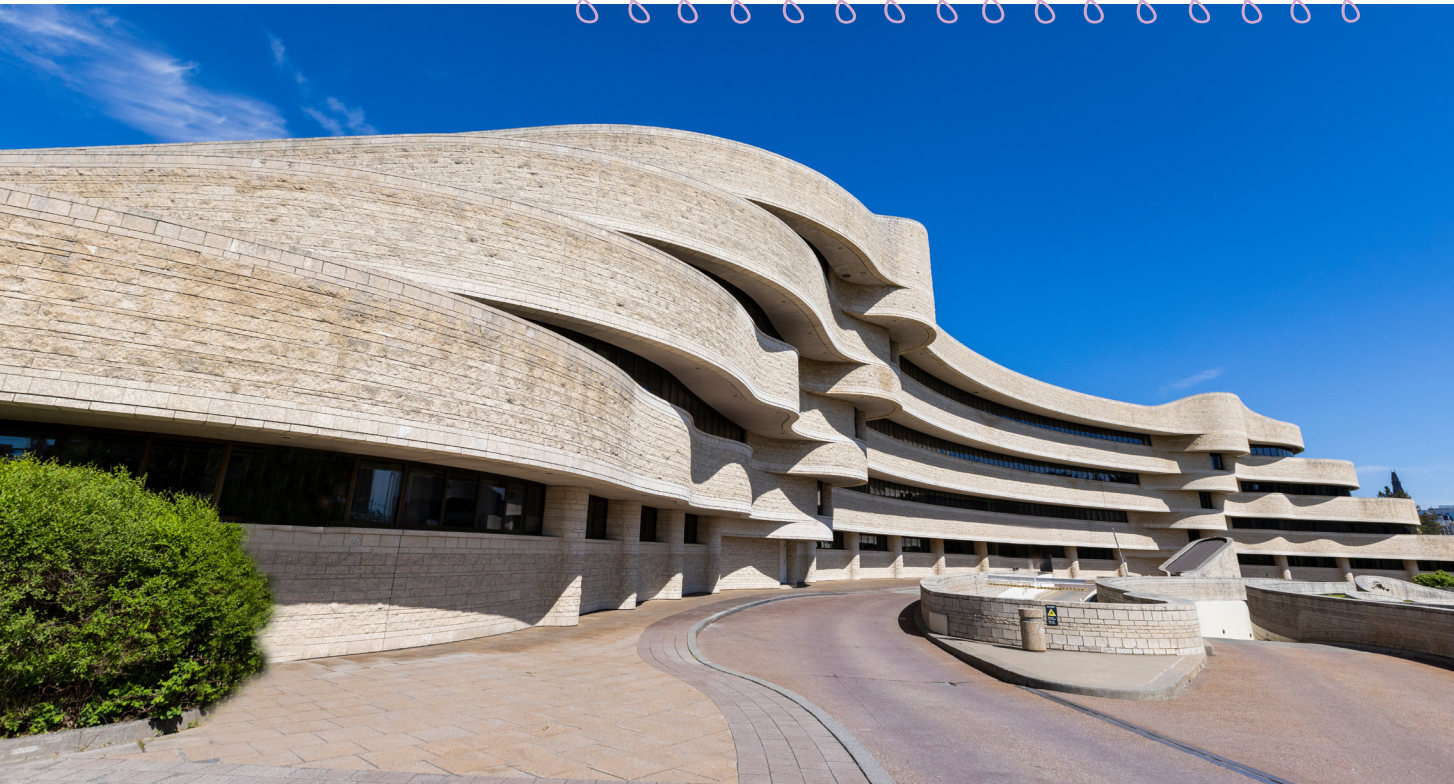

Ottawa wasn’t always the obvious choice for capital! In 1857, Queen Victoria chose Ottawa as Canada’s capital because it sat on the border between English-speaking Ontario and French-speaking Québec, making it a neutral choice symbolizing bilingualism and the coexistence of both cultures—values enshrined in the Official Languages Act over a century later, in 1969.
